I have served as a pastor in the Upper Columbia Conference for the past 20 years. Before that, I taught in the Religion Department at Weimar Institute. Previous to that, I pastored in the Iowa-Missouri Conference.

The development of my understanding of Daniel 11:40-45 may be summarized as follows:

Year   My Thinking on the Kings of the North and South

2000 – Christianity vs. Secularism

2005 – Christianity vs. Islam

2010 – Rulers in the Northern and Southern Divisions of Alexander's Former Empire

This represents a movement away from an entirely spiritualized view, toward an increasingly simplified approach to the text. It is a movement away from an interpretation wholly dependent upon the superimposing of an external scenario onto the text, toward allowing the text itself to drive its own application.
