I am the evangelist for the Idaho Conference of SDA. I present Daniel 11, Islam and Christianity in Prophecy seminars full time. We have a public 10 day evangelistic series and an SDA 1 to 6 hour versions that answer the questions Adventists ask.

I believe that after the death of Jesus in Daniel 11:22 the prophecy describes the conflict between the Papacy, called the little horn or King of the North in Daniel's writings, and Islam, the King of the South. This conflict comes in 3 stages, as mentioned in Daniel 11:29 and the 3 woes of Revelation. The first is Daniel 11:25-28, the Crusades. The second is Daniel 11:29-39, the time of the Ottoman conflict at the time of the reformation with a focus on the Papal persecution of God's people. The third is Daniel 11:40-45, the conflict in our time.

I have been studying prophecy since 1979 when I was in my late teens. In 2002 I realized that the Papal-Muslim conflict was a much better fit to the text of Daniel 11 than what I had been taught. I looked at Ellen G. White quotes but quickly learned that she did not give any definitive explanation of Daniel 11. I then began to study the scriptures and, secondarily, history. I did not base my study on what people said but on scripture. In 2008 I took another look at the writings of EGW. Now that I had immersed myself in the text of Daniel 11, I was then able to understand more from what she said. I discovered that what I had been finding was in harmony with what she taught. However, my understanding is not, nor should it be, EGW dependent. Several years later I learned that Roy Gane at Andrews University had come to the same conclusions regarding the identity of the Kings of the North and South from his study. I have since met many who have independently come to the same conclusions from their study of the text.

In 2011 the R&H published my book Islam and Christianity in Prophecy. In that book I laid out my understanding of Daniel 11 and showed that Daniel 11 has been fulfilled in history. It has not missed in the last 2500 years. I also gave my expectations of what to expect in the future. Since 2014 we have been having one fulfillment after another of these expectations. Meanwhile, our seminars continue to prove that Daniel 11 is a great foundation to reach the world for God.

I believe there are good people who love God and His word in all of the differing viewpoints on Daniel 11. If we are open to God and to each other, we will come together about the time of the "Loud Cry".
